- Fake food! Make sculptural art that looks good enough to eat!
- Create faux menus of restaurants we need in the community!
- Food photography! Photograph a meal you've made.
- Combine old spoons, rolling pins and other kitchen items to make an assemblage artwork.

- Must have a paid membership to the Visual Art League of Lewisville. Membership dues must be paid in advance of artwork being dropped off. (NO PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED ON INTAKE)
- NO AI will be accepted.
- You must pick up your artwork on the strike date or have a proxy pick up in your absence. No storage available.
